I. Welcome/Announcements—Rolf

II. Approval of February 2018 UBIC Meeting Minutes—Rolf

- a) Danica motioned to approve the minutes, Carrie seconded. Minutes approved.

III. Community Health Workers—Anna Guymon

- a) Community Health Workers (CHWs) strength is building trust and community capacity by networking with community and its partners and acting as a connector.
- b) Deep understanding or shared experiences with community help them in developing this trust and making connections.
- c) CHWs work in multiple settings to do their work i.e. schools hospitals, clinics, ect.
- d) Three C's Connectedness, Credibility, and Commitment.
- e) CHW do not replace existing team members but allow others to focus their efforts while they work with bridging with community.
- f) This is ideas about how CHW can help people with TBI
 1. Need trusted liaison to reintegrate into community and help people who do not have existing social support.
 2. Connect people with TBI to resources.

- a) Overwhelmed with need and underserved with resources.
- b) Want to develop career ladder for CHWs and professionalism as well as occupational standardization.
- c) CHWC Community Health Worker Collation working on legitimizing profession.
- d) Rolf talked about how CHWs could help UBIC.
- e) Danica talked about peer support specialist at the VA that would link nicely to the CHW.
- f) Traci mentioned that she is working on getting BI 101 into the CHW curriculum.

IV. Statewide Survey Results—Traci

- a) Traci reported that she would send out the survey reports that is not published yet but had a 2% increase in 3 years.

V. UBIC Group Updates, Group Chairs, and Agenda's for each—Rolf

- a) Rolf talked about we could continue to entice people to participate in UBIC.
- b) Joyce stated that we need to have people /agencies that are committed to come to have continued success. Also talked about how stipends helped people with brain injuries attend.
